

Ida Recreation Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order by Dave Stotz at 7:04 pm.

Old Business:

Equipment Order- JJ reported that the equipment has been ordered. We have received the balls already.

- JJ also reported that the Vinyl Clings for the helmets for All Stars have been ordered. She ordered 100. JJ also ordered an extra 25 prints of the shirt logo in case anyone wanted to buy a shirt at a later date. The money from the sales of these shirts would then be returned to the Larry Kreps III fund. It was requested to get pricing on window clings in case anyone would like one.

Maintenance Information:

- Dave will get the marker liner ordered from the co-op. He will also get paint for the paint liner.
- Weed Control-Can we get it done sooner? Dave will talk to Ed Wylie about this.

New Business:

All Stars

- Final counts for interest in All Star teams.
- Shari reported that there were approximately 15-17 girls interested. If this is the case, then we cannot have 2 teams. A 10U team has been put on hold until after the 12U tryouts.
- Travis reported that there were 24 boys interested. He wanted to know if we will be having 1 or 2 teams.

- There was discussion on how to divide the teams if there were two teams. Would there be an A or B team, or would the teams be separated equally. If separated equally, they would play in two tournaments and then pick the fair team after the second tournament so the team can play together.
- It was discussed that we would wait to see how many boys show up for tryouts before a decision is made on how many teams to have.
- Shari reported that there has been some confusion on what 10U or 12U means. The board will try and communicate this better. The board will be referring to the teams as 10 and under; 12 and under. To play on the 10 and under, you cannot turn 11 before Jan. 1 for girls, and May 1 for boys. To play on the 12 and under team, you cannot turn 13 before Jan. 1 for girls, and May 1 for boys.
- Boys 10 and under boys All Star tournament has been scheduled for July 18. The price will remain the same as last year. Kurt recommended Jeff Dusseau as the 10 and under coach. The board accepted this recommendation. The 10 and under tryouts will be on April 24 and 25 on fields 7 and 8.
- Shari reported there were schedule conflicts on fields. Field 5 will be in place of field 3. She also reported some coaching changes.

Umpire Clinic-Kay will check with Ned Birkey as to the dates for this. There will be a sign-up sheet in the high school.

- Pay for In-house umps will be \$25.00/game
- River Raisin umps will receive \$40.00 for certified and \$25.00 for field umps.

Field crew-will receive \$15.00/ day per person. (2 person crew)

Porta Johns-There will be 2, one by the V/JV girls diamonds and one by the boys fields. Will see about using the bathrooms at the concessions. There will also be 2 extra brought in for the tournament.

Gate-The gate will be locked at all times. No one is to park inside the gate.
